

Vaccination schedule for preschool children in Croatia for 2020.

In Croatia children have to get vaccination against 11 preventable disease: tuberculosis, hepatitis B, diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, haemophilus influenzae type B, measles, rubella, mumps and pneumococcus.

After birth: BCG vaccine (TBC) + Engerix B (hepatitis B) vaccine is given after birth only "to babies whose mothers are hepatitis B positive".

2 mo: Infanrix Hexa or Hexacima (Di-Te-aP-IPV-Hib-HB) + Synflorix or Prevenar 13

4 mo: Infanrix Hexa (Di-Te-aP-IPV-Hib-HB) + Synflorix or Prevenar 13

6 mo: Infanrix Hexa (Di-Te-aP-IPV-Hib-HB) + Synflorix or Prevenar 13 (only praematurus)

12 mo: MMR or Priorix

14 mo: Synflorix or Prevenar 13

18 mo: Pentaxim or Infanrix -Hib-IPV (Di-Te-aP-IPV-Hib)

5 years: Infanrix (Di-Te-aP)

If you want to buy vaccines in farmacy children can get vaccination for:

1. Varicella
2. Rota virus
3. Meningococcus

Before every winter season children older than 6 months, can be vaccinated against influenza – Vaxigrip tetra or Influvac tetra etc.
